

# Granny triangle pattern

(American terminology used)

1. ch 3, join to form a ring
2. ch 3 (= first dc), 2dc in same st, ch 2, 3dc in next st, ch2, 3dc in next st, ch 2 and join in the 3<sup>rd</sup> ch, sl through the stitches to the first ch sp
3. ch 3 (= first dc), 2dc in ch sp, ch 2, 3dc, [3dc in next ch sp, ch 2, 3dc] twice, join in the 3<sup>rd</sup> ch, sl through the stitches to the first ch sp
4. ch 3 (= first dc), 2dc in ch sp, ch 2, 3dc, 3dc in the next ch sp, [3dc in next ch sp (corner), ch 2, 3dc, 3dc in next ch sp] twice, join in the 3<sup>rd</sup> ch, sl through the stitches to the first ch sp  
Continue in the same fashion until your granny triangle is the size you want it.

Don't worry if you triangles curl or seem very un-triangle like – you can rectify that later.
